Below are the new designs that really moved at the last show.

As if the new tone and flake colors weren't enough, now we've got new baits styles with two of the most steady and effective colors in the inventory. All of this adds up to us having one of the best plastics bait line-ups to meet the needs of any situation. Muted tones, bright tones, stick baits, tubes, skirted twin tails, goby baits and drop shot tubes.

What's the difference between my baits and all the others? If a bait doesn't perform up to tournament quality standards, *I fire it*! No big name promotions, no hype to get a percentage of market share. Just a lot of hard work put behind each color, each style and then research done through the Combat Fishing Weekly Newsletter to back it up.
